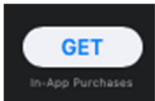


Connecting home Mac using Remote Desktop Connection to work PC

In order to remote into your office PC from home, you must have an up-to-date operating system or it will not work. For instance, Windows 7 is no longer supported and it is a security risk.

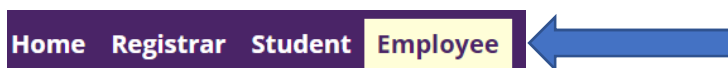
Go to the app store on your Mac
Search for Microsoft Remote Desktop



Select Get.

Log onto MyEC

Go to the Employee and click the link for Remote Desktop (RDP) on the left hand side.



You are here: Employee > Home



Then select the Remote Desktop (RDP) link

Connecting home Mac using Remote Desktop Connection to work PC

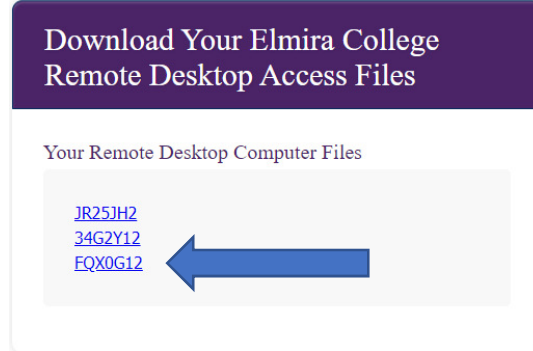
You will now see one of the below screens.

If you have one computer, this is your main office computer (image 1). Select the computer name.

If you see multiple computers, this means that you log into multiple computers (image 2). If you know which one is your main office computer select that, otherwise, you might have to do this process several times until you find the one that has the software needed.

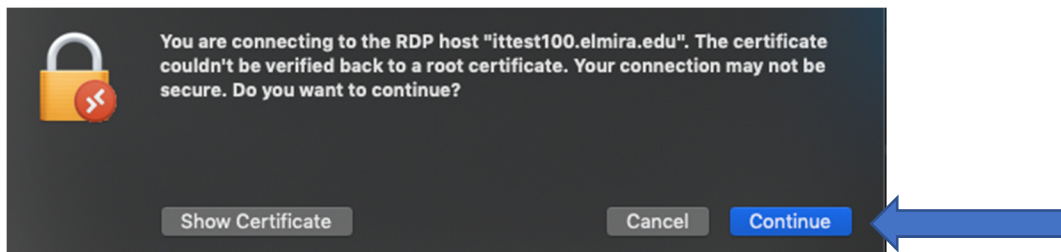

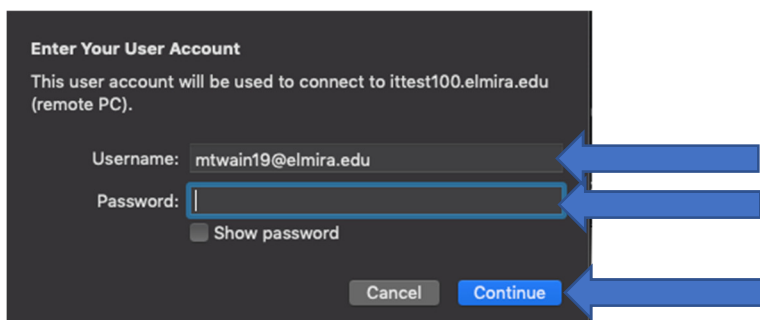
The file you will need to access the Remote Desktop will either show up in the bottom of your screen or in your downloads folder. Select the rdp file.



Select Continue



You will now be prompted to type in your username and password



Select Continue

You will now be able to remote into your PC desktop in your office. When you are done, you will log off the PC, like you always do.
